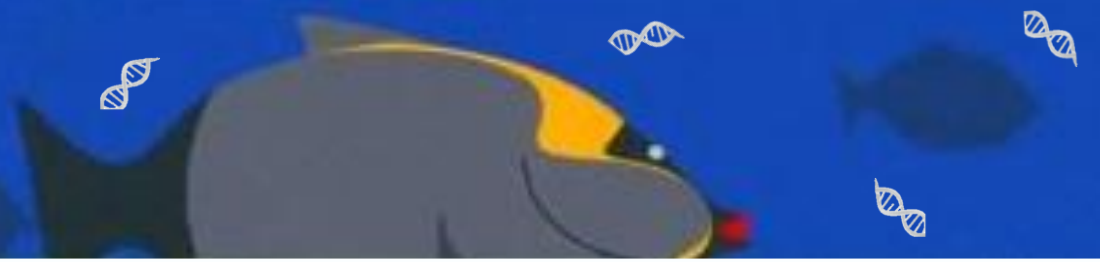
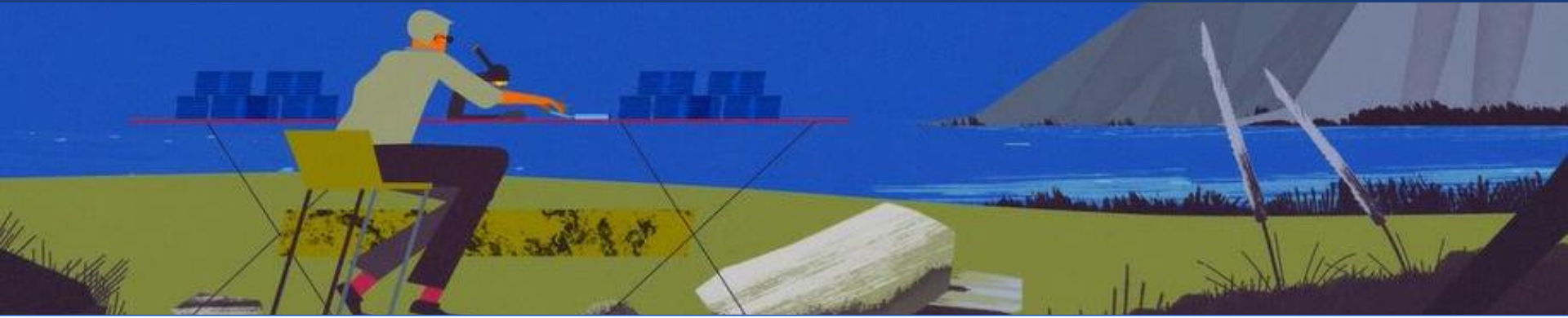


Fish leave their DNA in the water as they swim around in the sea.



Researchers can collect these DNA fragments by filtering sea water, extracting and sequencing the DNA, and comparing them to a reference database for identification.
