

Moray eels are cryptic, reef-dwelling animals that play important ecological roles on coral reefs around the world

Thousands of hours of baited remote underwater videos were analyzed to establish more accurate distribution patterns and abundance estimates in the Coral Triangle

There are probably many more species with inaccurate geographical ranges that further research can help discover



Unfortunately, not a lot is known about their biology, life history, population trends, or even global distributions

Several species that were recorded in the videos have been confirmed in new countries they were not previously documented in
